



CP21 (Community Policing in the 21st Century to Reduce Conflict) Training for Trainers (T4T)



TAPS

Description: This course is designed to effectively prepare law enforcement trainers (sworn and civilian L.E. employees) to provide their agency and community participants with trusted information delivered by an educational empowerment system designed to reduce violence and improve trust between peace officers and the community.

Course Objectives:

- Comprehend how community partnerships improve officer safety
- Recognize importance of “Event + Reaction = Outcome (E+R=O)” message
- Respond with appropriate action and de-escalation techniques
- Equip graduates with tested WYSM scenario-based course materials

Key Topics:

- Develop increased mutual respect and appreciation skills
- Explain a logical response based on critical thinking and quality communication skills
- Improve/Build social media, positive message campaigns, and classroom events
- Discuss “Best Practice” de-escalation and problem solving in the field
- Understand methods to connect with and empower your community
- Review the President’s Task Force on 21st Century Policing Report (May 2015)

Agency Return on Investment: 1) Reduce unnecessary conflicts with community, 2) Reduce violent contacts between community and police, and 3) Reduce civil court action.

Outcomes: Agency personnel will be prepared to teach a 2- to 4-hour community course plus a 4- to 8-hour peace officer course.
